Show in Cleveland. He is a retired educator and holds a doctorate in Educational Administration. His book brings awareness of the American Internment Program that had affected tens of thousands of German Americans during both world wars and includes personal stories of those who were sent to the interment camps. He presents a description of history on the destruction and unconditional surrender of Germany and describes many personal stories about the mistreatment, mass murder, starvation, the expulsion of million of ethnic Germans and raping of women by occupying forces in Europe. It is a history story that not too many know of the human rights violations in America's internment program and of the brutality against Germans in Europe at the end of and following the war. It is an interesting read. You can purchase the book online.

Transylvanian Saxon Trivia: The Reps citadel is located on the hilltop of the town and is one of the oldest archaeological sites in Romania with the first signs of human settlements dating back to the Paleolithic and early Neolithic eras. The Transylvanian Saxons built on the ruins of a former Dacian fort in the 14th century. It was used for defense and a shelter for the townspeople. The citadel was the administrative capital of one of the Seven Saxon Seats in Transylvania. Reps represented the last stronghold of the Transylvanian Saxons against the Hungarian prince of Transylvania Thomas Szecseny and the King of Hungary Charles Robert of Anjou during the early part of the 14th century. Dur-

ing the **plague** of 1716, the citadel was used as refuge for those who were not affected by disease, and in 1788 as refuge against Turkish invasion. The citadel was finally abandoned in 1790 after a severe storm that destroyed its roof. Since then, the citadel was left in ruins, although Reps became in interwar period a Saxon cultural center. During the communist regime, the authorities planned the demolition of the citadel in order to exploit the basalt that forms the hill. The last attempt to restore the citadel dates back to 1954, but the idea was abandoned. In the early 1990s, the citadel was in ruins, with only one of the defense towers standing. Between 2010 and 2013, the citadel has undergone a comprehensive restoration process that restored all the seven towers and the town homes.




