Schloss Horneck needs OUR help!

Since 1960 Schloss Horneck has housed the Siebenbürg-Museum, the Siebenbürger Library and Archive, the Siebenbürger-Institut and is the base for many Saxon organizations. A seniors home is also located on the property. Last September the Verband der Siebenbürger Sachsen in Deutschland purchased the property for one million Euro.



Donations were received from individuals and organizations to help fund the purchase of the property. The purchase of Schloss Horneck gives the Siebenbürger Saxons throughout the world a central location where Saxon artifacts, books and other historical documents can be collected and stored to preserve our ethnic history for many years.

Transylvanian Saxon Trivia: Historians debate exactly who invented the first automatic windshield wiper. Some scholars suggest William M. and Fred Folberth, two brothers born in Mediasch who came to Cleveland, Ohio in the early 1900, invented the automatic windshield wiper. The Folberths invented the wiper in 1919, however, William did not receive a patent for the product until August 16, 1921. They had begun to manufacture the wiper in a factory in Cleveland in 1925. The Folberths' automatic wipers got their power from the motor via a tube. Air was diverted from the motor to make them work using the vacuum principle. The wiper would slow down and speed up as the car slowed down or sped up and drivers desired a more consistent wiper, so during the 1930s, dramatic improvements occurred in electrical wipers, making the Folberths' version obsolete. They owned the Automotive Development Company in Cleveland and eventually owned over 100 patents. So, when you are driving in the rain or snowfall you can thank two Transylvanian Saxons for coming up with the invention of automatic windshield wipers!

Opening a custodial investment account for children

Parents can open brokerage accounts for their children and get tax breaks, according to The Motley Fool. Custodial accounts are so named because they are opened in the name of the parent and will remain under their control until the child turns 18 or 21 (depending on the state) and assumes ownership.

Other than the transfer of ownership, these brokerage accounts are the same as any other and investments can be made into any of the brokerage's offerings. Any withdrawals or earnings from the account will be taxed at the child's rate which is typically much lower than the household's. Money can be pulled out to cover certain expenses that would benefit the child.

They can gather your passwords from any account you log into from social sites to vour bank.

Stay safe using these free wi-fi guidelines:

- 1. Never log in to your bank account or make payment for anything.
- 2. Check for the https prefix before the web address. The S shows that the connection is secure.
- 3. Avoid using an app on your smartphone or tablet when on free wi-fi.
- 4. Log out from websites you use. If you do not, a hacker could use the website in your name.
- 5. Don't use the same password for everything. A hacker on a free wi-fi network can get the password you are using and test it on other sites, even your bank.
- 6. Change your passwords frequently.

Cataracts: You can have your sight back

Cataracts, a clouding of the eye lens, have been known and diagnosed since at least 29 AD, but the treatments, until the 1940s according to the Mayo or so, have probably been worse than the problem.

With age, it is very common to suffer some vision loss from the clouding of the natural eye lens. According to the World Health Organization, agerelated cataracts are responsible for 51 percent of world blindness. In North America, about 42 percent of people have lens changes between ages 42 and 64. That percentage rises to 91 percent by age 75.

Today, cataracts are repaired surgically by inserting a foldable plastic lens

to replace the natural one. Surgery is very safe and effectively restores vision. Symptoms of cataracts,



The Bowling tournament will be held in Merriville, IN on October 20-21.




