She is dedicated to serving our Fraternal Family and is anxious to help in its growth. We are so happy to welcome her to our ATS Home Office Staff and look forward to her many years of service to our organization.

We recently have redesigned our website and it was launched several weeks ago. We still have more updates to make, but wanted to get it up and running. You are now able to read the current issues of the *Volksblatt* online. We hope this pleases our members and friends that wait for several weeks to receive the current issue of the newspaper. Please go to www.atsaxons.com. On the top navigation heading, simply go to Volksblatt and then choose the issue you wish to read. We also have listed under About Us, answers to frequently asked questions. Under Events, there is a calendar showing the date of the Branches' monthly meetings as well as local and national events. You may also find our life plan rates schedules for the different life products. This can come in handy if you want to see how much it would cost to purchase a Life Plan for your children, grandchildren or yourself. We hope this redesign will help our members stay current with the society's activities.

With the start of the Fall season our local branches are providing many various events. October looks to be a very busy month for our ATS Branches. There are still several Branch Oktoberfests (New Castle and Ellwood City); Branch 19's 50 Year Dinner; Sausage Sales by Youngstown Saxon Culture Group and Salem, Cleveland's Traubenfest; Detroit's Hunters' Banquet and several Branch Halloween parties. Plus, the ATS Open-Bowling Tournament will be held the weekend of October 22 – 23rd in New Castle. The New Castle Bowlers have promised us a weekend of great Gemütlichkeit. Hopefully, you have signed up for the tournament to share in the fun. How great it is to report that our ATS Branches are working hard to provide social events for their members and local communities.

On Saturday, October 1st we held an ATS Deputies sales seminar at the Home Office. This main topic of this seminar was focused on Traditional and ROTH IRAs. We want our Deputies to be versed on selling IRAs to an individual so they can explain the differences of a Traditional vs. ROTH IRA and the difference of a Rollover and Transfer. Although it is never too late to save for your retirement, you will get more from your savings by beginning early. The more time that you have to save with an IRA, the greater the power of compounding interest and its effect on your savings. So, to our young members and their friends, if you are just starting to build your career, consider starting an ATS IRA. And if you own IRAs, it is important to know that there are two ways to move money between IRAs: 1) Transfers. which are not reported to the IRS and not reported on a tax return. The IRA owner never touches the money. You can do this as often as you like, whenever you like. 2) Rollovers, with this method, the IRA owner takes the money as a distribution and they have 60-days to rollover (put back) the amount in an IRA. An individual can only do one IRA Roll-over once per 12-month period. An ATS IRA can help you securely face your financial future during your retirement years.

Transylvanian Saxon Trivia: A significant part of the Saxon colonies emerged from the modern day Luxembourg (Moselle Franconian area) which explains why the Transylvanian Saxon dialect is linguistically the closest relative of the Luxembourgish dialect which is a branch of the German language comprising of a series of West Central German dialects.

Since 1960 Schloss Horneck has housed the Siebenbürger Siebenbürger Museum, the Library and Archive, the Siebenbürger-Institut and is the base for many Saxon organizations. A seniors home is also located on the property. Last September the Verband der Siebenbürger Sachsen in Deutschland purchased the property for one million Euro.



Donations were received from individuals and organizations to help fund the purchase of the property. The purchase of Schloss Horneck gives the Siebenbürger Saxons throughout the world a central location where Saxon artifacts, books and other historical documents can be collected and stored to preserve our ethnic history for many years.

ATS OPEN-BOWLING TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. All bowlers must be Alliance of Transylvanian Saxon members in good standing to participate in this tournament
- 2. Each bowler will receive 100% of the difference between his or her average and a two hundred ten (210) scratch with no limit on pins.
- 3. Averages to be used are:
 - a) The average of the past five years' tournaments.
 - b) If the bowler has no tournament average then the bowler will establish his or her average after the first three games rolled in the tournament, which will remain the bowler's average for the remainder of the tournament.
- 4. A bowler may bowl only once in each event in this tournament.
- 5. The tournament management has the right to return for correction any entry, which does not comply with the above rules.
- 6. Prizes will be awarded at the ratio of at least one (1) prize for each ten entries. One hundred percent of the prize fee must be returned. Prizes will be awarded by handicapped scores and not by gender.
- 7. It shall be the duty of the tournament manager to keep a running record of all bowlers' averages participating in each event.
- 8. Tournament starts on October 22 and ends on October 23, 2016.
- 9. Closing date for entries is October 12, 2016.
- 10. There will be no refunds of fees after October 19, 2016.
- 11. All Event Winners will be determined by actual scores bowled.
- 12. We will start with Doubles Event followed by the Singles Event on Saturday.

All Events will be a handicap event this year. Your all events final score will be your total individual score of singles, doubles, and team event plus your handicap total for the tournament. Separate men and women prizes will only be awarded in Singles event only. Doubles and team

Birthdays for the month are Eileen Ring, Marge Teutsch and Julia Roberts. Best wishes were extended to each and everyone.



Hahn and MikeTeutsch Sr. are nearer and can explain the situation easier.



OUR FAVORITE RECIPES

Zwetschgen Streuselkuchen

Ingredients:

(1 baking sheet or 2 springform tins)

For the dough:

3 1/8 cups (400g) all-purpose flour 3/4 cup (150g) sugar

1/3 cup (80g) butter, softened 2/3 cup (150ml) milk

1 egg

1 oz. (30g) fresh yeast pinch of salt

For the topping:

35-42 oz. (1-1,2kg) damson plums

For the Streusel:

3/4 cup (150g) cane sugar (e.g. Muscovado)

1 1/8 cup (150g) all-purpose flour 1/2 cup (110g) cold butter

pinch of salt

1/2 tsp. ground cinnamon

Directions:

1. Sift the flour in a bowl. Make a little hollow in the middle and add the crumbled yeast. Add a teaspoon of the sugar and some tablespoons of the lukewarm milk and stir until the yeast has dissolved almost completely. Dust with some of the flour and cover with a kitchen towel. Let raise in a warm place for 10 minutes.

- 2. For the streusel: In a bowl mix flour, sugar, salt and cinnamon. Add the cold butter in small pieces and mix with your fingers to form small crumbles. Let cool in the fridge.
- 3. Mix the flour and yeast-mix with the remaining milk, sugar, softened butter and salt and knead until you get a smooth dough. Cover and let raise in a warm place for 30 minutes.
- 4. Preheat the oven to 390°F (200°C). While the dough is raising, wash and dry the plums. Remove the stones and cut the plums (you should get quarters that are still connected). Prepare a baking sheet (or two springform tins) with baking parchment. Roll out the dough and place on the sheet or the springform tins. Form only a small rim. Place the plums on the dough – one close to another – sprinkle with the streusel and bake for about 30 minutes. The dough shound be well baked but not dark.


