PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Thank you to everyone who attended the 2023 North American Transylvanian Saxon Heimattag in New Castle, PA. From the comments I have received, everyone had a great time. It was a special celebration with good food, good people and spectacular entertainment. This Heimattag was three years in the making, as it was first scheduled to be held in 2020, along with the Federation of Transylvanian Saxons' Cultural Exchange Program with our Saxon friends from Traun, Austria.

Special thanks to all our Cultural Groups who performed on Friday night and Saturday. The Youngstown Culture Group's Brass Band welcomed the Traun group at the New Castle picnic grounds with music. Then, the group played for our evening entertainment. During one of the band breaks, the New Castle Eintracht Männerchor led a Sing-A-Long with the guests. The New Castle Branch 25 picnic grounds were beautiful, and everyone had the chance to wander around or sit inside with the music. What a nice evening.

Our Saturday started with lunch and then church service. The New Castle Kinderchor and the New Castle Eintracht Männerchor sang selections during the service. The Youngstown Saxon Brass Band played again for the Prelude and church hymns. Thank you to Reverend David A. Snyder of St. John's Lutheran Church (ELCA) in New Castle for the church service and relevant sermon about Home/Heimat. Following the service, the singing of the National Anthems started our Heimattag program. After a beautiful Auf Marsch, the cultural performances began with the New Castle Kinderchor singing again. The Cleveland Saxon Youth Dance Group and the Cleveland Saxon Dance Group danced individually and together. The Cleveland Eintracht Saxonia Sachsenchor sang beautifully followed by more dancing with the Aylmer Saxonia Hall Dancers and the Kitchener Transylvania Club Dancers. Then, the afternoon cultural performances concluded with the follow-up performance by the New Castle Eintracht Männerchor.

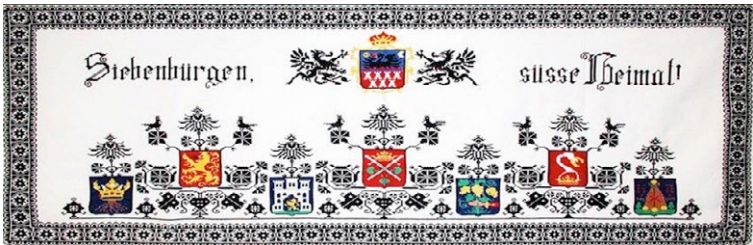

Make your diamonds sparkle again

Your diamonds can sparkle like new with this simple technique:

Mix three parts water to one part ammonia and immerse the diamond in the solution.

Rinse the diamond under a faucet and dry with a soft towel.

The solution isn't appropriate for sapphires or emeralds.

Never use soap on a diamond. It leaves a cloudy film.

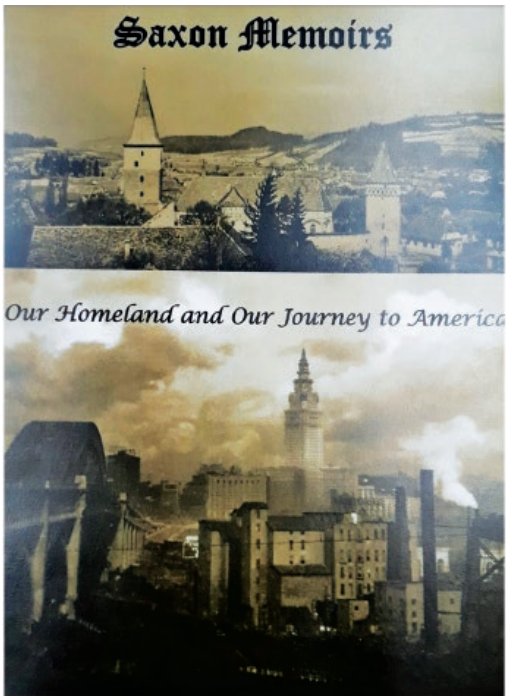

**Scary:
What happens when
you get your wind
knocked out**

The medical term for it is phrenospasm, but we usually say 'we got the wind knocked out' of us.

One hard hit to the chest or abdomen, for example, can cause the diaphragm to spasm or even paralyze for a moment. The lungs empty, and gasping for air is impossible for at least a couple seconds. It's scary and intensely uncomfortable.

Most of the time, the diaphragm will naturally relax and force an instant deep breath within a couple of seconds. If you have the wind knocked out of you, try to remain calm and when you take the deep breath, remain still, breathing deeply and steadily. There should be no long-term consequences.

However, if a person is hit in the chest and faints, this can mean the blow affected the heart and it could be an emergency. If a person falls and hits their head, that can suggest a concussion and the person should seek immediate medical attention.

Interestingly people can also become become acutely winded, meaning severe shortness of breath. The causes for this are usually more serious than phrenospasm. It can occur with anxiety or lung disease. This should be evaluated by a doctor.
