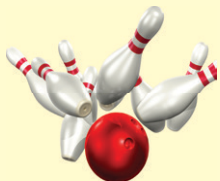

The 2024 ATS Convention is fast approaching. At least for the ATS Home Office it is. The 108th Convention will be held May 18th and 19th and hosted by Branch 30 at the Youngstown Saxon Club. The Constitution Committee of the Board of Directors has proposed some changes to the ATS Constitution. These proposed changes have been mailed out to all of the Branches for discussion at your meetings. The changes are posted in this issue of the Volksblatt. They will be included in the next two issues as well. In addition, each Branch should have received their Delegate forms. These forms will need to be returned to the ATS Home Office by April 3rd (45 days before the Convention). Each form shows the number of Delegates that Branch is entitled to send to the Convention (minimum of 2, with a maximum of 12).

Have you been working on your Handicraft item for the Convention? In addition to reports from the ATS Board of Directors, Subsidy and Branch Sharing checks being distributed, each Convention has a contest for different types of handiwork. You still have time to start on that project and get it completed before May.

College students: please do not forget about the deadlines for the ATS Scholarships. Request forms need to be received by the Home Office by March 15th. Completed applications need to be returned by April 15th. The ATS will be awarding over 40 scholarships again this year. We are very proud to offer this benefit to our ATS members!

added to the Roman calendar. The calendar was originally 10 months, because winter was considered a dormant, month-less period. January and February were added by the Roman King Pompilius to better align with the lunar year. Why is February usually 28 days? The Roman King Numa had originally made all months 29 days, since Romans believed that even numbers were unlucky. However, adding up 12 months of 29 days, the sum is an even number. So, February, a month for honoring the dead, was chosen as the unlucky month to consist of 28 days.

Over time, many changes have been made to the calendar, but the 28 figure has remained (mostly) for February. The month includes Groundhog Day, Lunar/Chinese New Year, the Super Bowl, President Lincoln’s birthday, Fat/Shrove Tuesday or Mardi Gras Day, Ash Wednesday, Valentine’s Day, Susan B Anthony’s birthday, President Washington’s birthday, and of course, Leap Day. Some fun observances include: Tater Tot Day, Ukulele Day, Carrot Cake Day, Golden Retriever Day, Homemade Soup Day, Pay a Compliment Day, Send a Card to a Friend Day, Fettuccine Alfredo Day, Bubble Gum Day, Pizza Day, Read in the Bathtub Day, Clean Out your Computer Day (I totally missed that one!), Don’t Cry Over Spilled Milk Day, Drink Wine Day (I got that one!), Sticky Bun Day, Tell a Fairy Tale Day, and Love Your Pet Day.

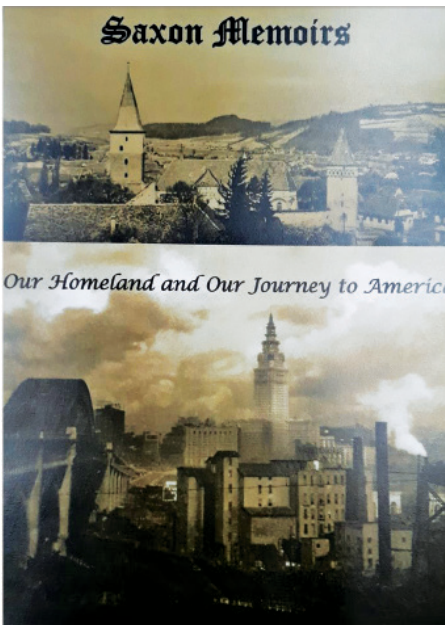

New ovarian cancer treatment heads to clinical trials

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration has granted fast-track designation to a new therapy for aggressive ovarian, fallopian tube, and peritoneal cancer, according to Targeted Oncology. Developed by the Chinese firm RemeGen, RC88 is designed for patients with treatment-resistant cancers and poor prognoses. Phase 2 clinical trials are slated to begin soon.

Proposed changes to ATS constitution

The following changes to the Constitution of the Alliance of Transylvanian Saxons are presented by the ATS Board of Directors for Convention consideration and approval. The following changes are being presented to update and modernize our Constitution, our business policies and procedures, and comply with new corporate governance requirements and regulator recommendations.

ARTICLE III - Rights of the Alliance

Currently reads:
SECTION 3. It shall collect dues and payments as its Constitution, rules, laws and by-laws provide, elect its own officers, and have the right and duty to regulate and supervise the activities of individual Branches in matters affecting the Alliance.

Proposed change:
Remove the words “dues and”

**Proposed wording to read:
SECTION 3. It shall collect payments as its Constitution, rules, laws and by-laws provide, elect its own officers, and have the right and duty to regulate and supervise the activities of individual Branches in matters affecting the Alliance.**

Reason for change: The ATS no longer collects any dues from its members on behalf of local Branches.

ARTICLE IV – Governing Body

Proposed change:
Add new Section 3

**Proposed wording to read:
Section 3: Authority of the Convention is suspended in the event of an authorized control level Risk Based Capital (RBC) event (insolvency of the ATS) as required under Ohio Revised Code Sec 3921.102, and in such event, all requirements of the Ohio Revised Code apply, including, but not limited to, authority of the Board to approve a transfer or merger, and requirements for notice to members.**

Reason for change: The State of Ohio has enacted new solvency rules for Fraternal Benefit Societies. This is their requested wording to be added to Constitutions of Fraternal. (The Ohio Department of Insurance can intervene and possibly take over a Fraternal Benefit Society if their RBC ratio falls below 200%.)

ARTICLE VIII – Election of Officers

Currently reads:

SECTION 5. A Branch nominating committee must make nominations in writing to the Alliance Board of Directors 60 days prior to the date of the Convention. The nomination must include a short description of the candidate’s background and qualifications, and written permission from the candidate to let his or her name stand for election. The candidate must be elected as a delegate and must attend the Convention. When the nomination date has passed, the Board of Directors will provide the Alliance Branches with the list of nominees and their qualifications. Incumbent Officers of the Alliance are eligible for re-election and, if not present at the Convention, must send in writing a “consent to be nominated.”

Proposed change:
Remove the words “nominating committee”

**Proposed wording to read:
SECTION 5. A Branch must make nominations in writing to the Alliance Board of Directors 60 days prior to the date of the Convention. The nomination must include a short description of the candidate’s background and qualifications, and written permission from the candidate to let his or her name stand for election. The candidate must be elected as a delegate and must attend the Convention. When the nomination date has passed, the Board of Directors will provide the Alliance Branches with the list of nominees and their qualifications. Incumbent Officers of the Alliance are eligible for re-election and, if not present at the Convention, must send in writing a “consent to be nominated.”**

Reason for change: Not all Branches utilize a nominating committee to select a candidate for an ATS Board of Directors position.

ARTICLE IX – Duties of Officers

Currently reads:
SECTION 8 subsection a. He (Chief Medical Examiner) shall carefully examine all applications for membership in the Alliance and have full power

to accept or reject same.

Proposed change:
Insert the words “life insurance”

**Proposed wording to read:
SECTION 8 subsection a. He shall carefully examine all life insurance applications for membership in the Alliance and have full power to accept or reject same.**

Reason for change: The ATS Chief Medical Examiner only reviews and approves life insurance applications. Annuity applications are not sent to him for review.

ARTICLE XIV – Duties and Rights of Members

Currently reads:
SECTION 1, subsection b. Certificate premium payments or any other monies due the national Alliance may be paid by the member to the ATS Secretary of the local Branch in which he is a member or paid directly to the ATS Home Office.

Proposed change:
Remove the words “may be paid by the member to the ATS Secretary of the local Branch in which he is a member”

**Proposed wording to read:
SECTION 1, subsection b. Certificate premium payments or any other monies due the national Alliance must be paid directly to the ATS Home Office.**

Reason for change: For years now, no members have paid their insurance premiums at their local Branch meeting.

ARTICLE XIV – Duties and Rights of Members

Currently reads:
SECTION 2. Local Branch Dues Payment. At the option and subsequent request of the local Branch, the ATS Home Office will incorporate the handling of local Branch Dues in the ATS Direct Billing procedures and accept local dues payments under the following stipulations:

- Members must pay their local dues according to the same payment mode in which their certificate premium payments are made.
- Local dues payments may be paid by member to the local Branch Financial Secretary or paid directly to the ATS Home Office.
- A record of local dues received and the monies involved will be forwarded by the ATS Office to each Branch monthly.

Proposed change:
Remove wording related to the ATS Home Office handling the billing, collection, and remittance of local Branch Dues

**Proposed wording to read:
Section 2. Local Branch Dues Payment. All local dues are to be paid directly to their local Branch.**

Reason for change: The ATS no longer collects any dues from its members on behalf of local Branches.

ARTICLE XVI – Duties and Rights of Branches

Currently reads:
SECTION 6 – Every Branch shall be responsible for all funds collected by its Secretary for the Alliance and must see to it that all such funds are delivered to the designated depository within the specified time. When a Branch, without explanation, neglects to send in the funds and reports promptly, it shall receive a warning from the Secretary of the Alliance. Should the Branch neglect to fulfill its duties within ten days of the receipt of the warning, the Alliance shall compel the Branch to comply with these requirements by any necessary procedures including court action and recommend suspension of the Branch and denial of the right to send Delegates to the Convention.

Proposed change:
Delete the entire Section 6 wording.

**Proposed wording to read:
Section 6 removed in its entirety. Section 7 would become Section 6 and Section**

8 would become Section 7.
Reason for change: There are no funds being collected by the Branch to be remitted to the ATS Home Office any longer.

ARTICLE XVII – Duties of Branch Officers

Currently reads:
SECTION 3. The Branch ATS Secretary is responsible for the financial collections and records of the Alliance within his Local Branch.

- He shall collect all payments due the Alliance from members at each regular meeting of the Branch and remit them to the Alliance Home Office within five days after the meeting.
- He shall complete and forward to the office of the Alliance all required reports within five days after the meeting.

Proposed change:
Replace the words “financial collections and” with “membership”. Delete sections a and b

**Proposed wording to read:
The Branch ATS Secretary is responsible for the membership records of the Alliance within his local Branch. Sections a and b removed in their entirety. Sections c, d, and e would become sections a, b, and c.**

Reason for change: There are no funds being collected by the Branch to be remitted to the ATS Home Office any longer.

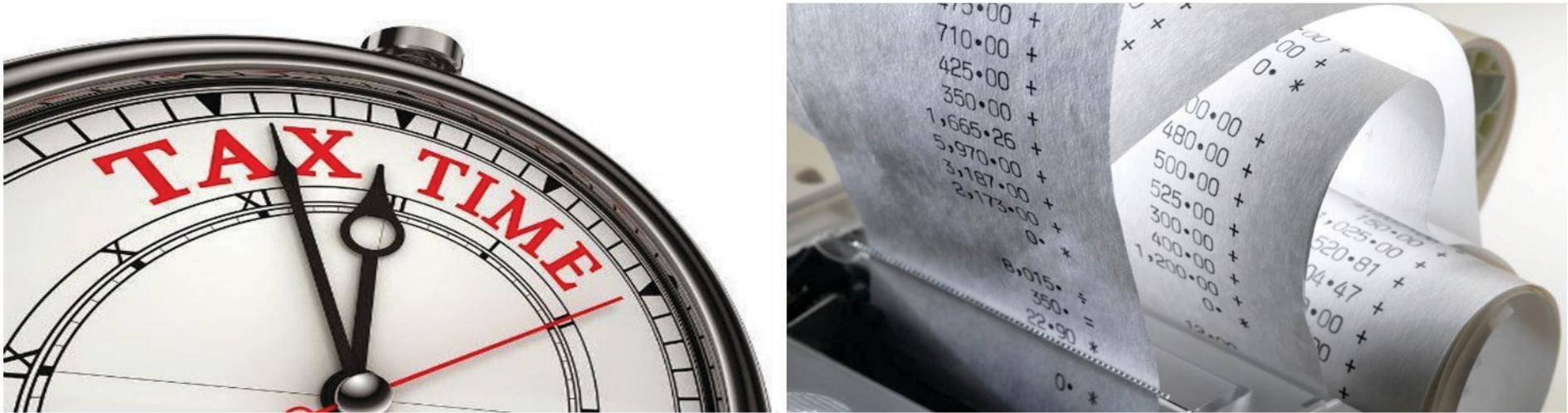

It's Tax Time!

The ATS wants to remind our members that it is not too late to make a contribution to either your Roth IRA or your Traditional IRA for the 2023 tax year. You have until the tax filing deadline of Monday, April 15th to make a contribution for last year. If you do not have an ATS Traditional or Roth IRA and you have earned income (generally wages or self-employed income), we recommend that you start one now.

An ATS Individual Retirement Arrangement (IRA) is a smart way to save, combining two incredibly powerful forces: compounded interest and tax savings. Both the Traditional and Roth versions allow you to enjoy tax advantages while saving for your future.

With an ATS Traditional IRA, investment earnings are tax-deferred, so you pay tax only when you withdraw funds after retirement. Contributions to the Traditional IRA may be deductible on your Federal income tax return. (Please consult your tax advisor.)

With an ATS Roth IRA, all withdrawals are tax free, including the earnings, for withdrawals after five years and attaining age 59 1/2. Contributions are not deductible on your tax return, but the tax free withdrawals in the future will usually make up for that. (Please consult your tax advisor.)

The ATS has no administrative charges on your accounts. No annual fee, no statement fee, no service fee. (There could be a surrender charge if you make a withdrawal in the first five years.) Contact your local sales deputy or the ATS Home Office if you are interested in opening a tax-advantaged IRA.

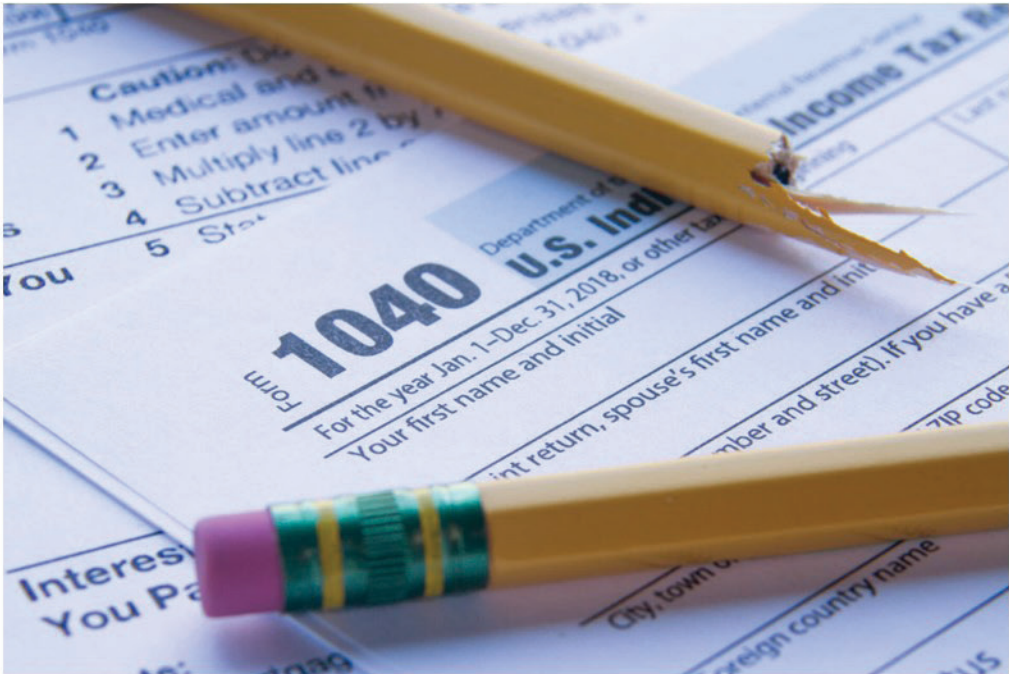
For those of you with existing ATS Traditional or Roth IRA's, you can always contribute as little or as much as allowed (see contribution limits below) into your IRA account for each tax year. Even a contribution of a few hundred dollars a year will make a difference in your retirement years.

For those who have an IRA account elsewhere, please check out your earnings rate and the fees that you pay for that account. It might make sense to transfer your IRA account to the ATS.
